Class Dates	Instructor	Course #	Course Description
01/24/13 - 01/26/13	Baldwin	PT580	The Theology of Spiritual Development: This is a study of the believers daily, devotional life. It is a careful mix of both the "whys" and how tos" of daily devotions
02/21/13 - 02/23/13		NT130	A Study of Matthew Part I: This is a study of the first twelve chapters of the Gospel of Matthew. This course will focus on Matthews major themes; the meanings of the teachings to the early Church; the character, person and work of Jesus; and the activity of the Holy Spirit in the life and ministry of Jesus.
03/28/13 - 03/30/13	Cottle	NT560	Paul: The Man: This is a study of the life, conversion and travels of the Apostle Paul based upon the biblical evidence from Acts and certain Epistles. It also includes an analysis and overview of several of Pauls letters. These are studied chronologically
04/25/13 - 04/27/13	Sheats	CC660	You Can Have A Happy Family: This course examines the Biblical principles to guide a Christian family. Topics include the role of the husband, the role of the wife, parenting skills and family finances. A solid, biblical, model of effective family living is presented
05/23/13 - 05/25/13	Clark	BT520	The Believer's Authority: This course examines the unseen forces at work in the world. Particular emphasis is given to the origin of Satan, his motivation for attacking Gods creation and Jesus victory to give believers authority over him.
06/27/13 - 06/29/13	Amsden	BT821	Law and Grace: This course is designed to point out the believers view and obligation to the holy law of God. Topics includes an examination of Gods purpose in giving the law, mans responsibility toward the law, and the new covenant application of the law.
08/22/13- 08/24/13	Bond	BT451	Developing Sound Hermeneutics: This course introduces students to the principles of biblical interpretation. Emphasis is placed upon the accurate interpretation of types, allegories, prophecy and parables contained in scripture.
09/26/13 - 9/28/13	Beall	BT510	Laying the Foundation: The purpose of this study is to examine the doctrine of salvation in terms of the "foundation stones" as outlined in Hebrews 6:1-3.
10/24/13 - 10/26/13	Gaulden	OT660	Genesis and the Grace of God: The prevailing undercurrent of this course will focus on God's grace in confrontation with man's sin, from Adam to Jacob.
11/21/13 - 11/23/13	Drye	PT341	Crucified Life: This is a study of scriptural self-denial. It helps the student to gain a greater understanding of the centrality of the cross and identification with the death of Christ as the means to glory and a victorious life.
